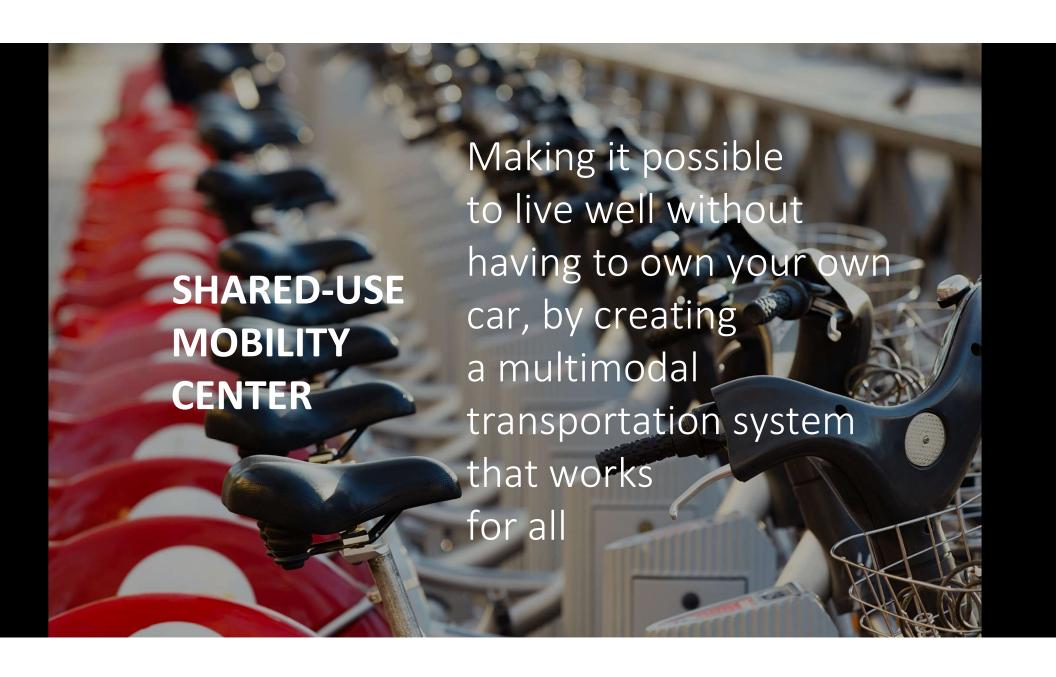

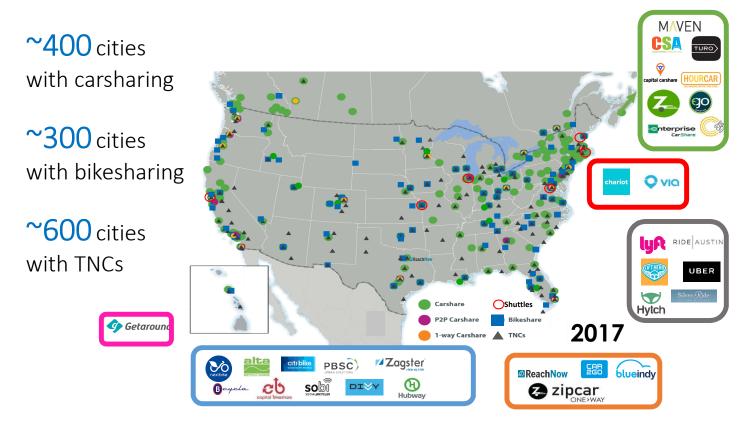
Types of Public-Private Partnerships (P3s) include:

Growing Numbers of Shared-Mobility Companies

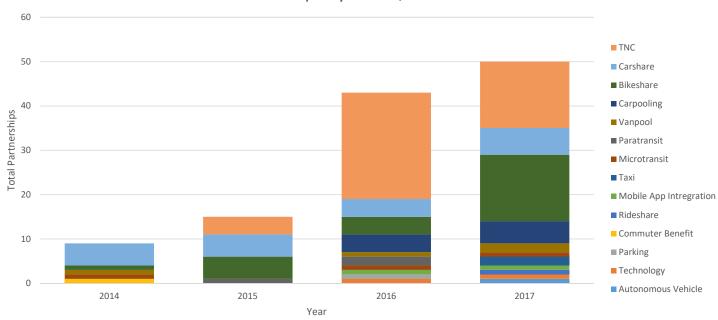




Tracking Shared Mobility Partnerships

MOD is a *vision* for an integrated multi-modal network of safe, carefree, affordable, and reliable transportation options that are available to ALL







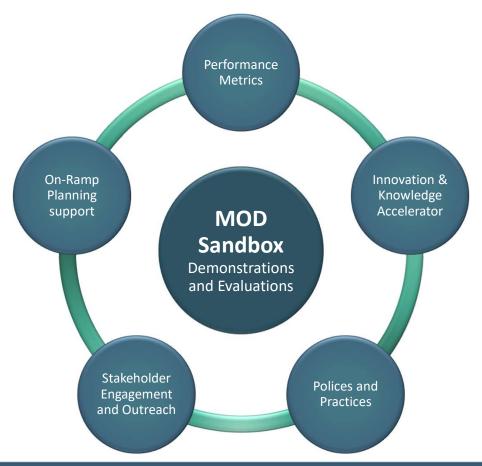

- Free technical assistance for transit agencies
- Develop innovative ideas into fundable solutions
- Work on developing MOD business plan

Why It's Needed

- Sandbox received a lot of ideas that showed promise but needed more development
- Those ideas & others shouldn't be lost
- Will increase the MOD knowledge base & advance vision

Eligible Applicants

- Providers of public transportation
- Involves shared mobility project partner
- Innovative idea
- Support from leadership & commitment

Possible Partners

Does not need to be formalized for proposal

- Private providers of shared mobility
- Governmental partners
- Community groups

- Initial Site Visits
 - Develop technical assistance plan
- On-Site Workshops
 - Analysis with remedies identified
- Peer-to-Peer Support
 - Summits
 - Webinars
 - Online forum
- Ongoing Technical Assistance
 - Support on identified challenges
 - Modeling & research
 - Management support with contracts & data sharing agreements
 - Pilot project development planning





On-Ramp Product: MOD Business Plan

Business Plan Will:

- Determine Mobility Needs
- Assess the Market Conditions
- Provide the Framework for a P3
- Identify Barriers & Solutions
- Calculate Potential Social & Economic Benefits
- Outline an Implementation Strategy
- Develop Marketing & Outreach Plan
- Identify Potential Funding Sources



The Business Plan will be tool that can be used to help bring a project from idea to launch



Evaluation Criteria

- Up to six project will be selected
- Proposals will be evaluated by MOD practitioners & scored accordingly
 - Mobility Need
 - Project Idea
 - Community Support
 - Agency Support
